Now, Teresa has perfect vision in both eyes. She helps others every day.

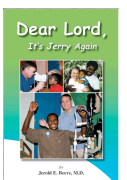


Beni and Sally in 1995 after their successful surgeries at ages 16 and 18. They lived with the Beeves for three months.
